I. REQUIRED COURSES & CREDITS :: Graduation Requirements = 220 Credits

ENGLISH

- English 9 A-B 40 Credits
- English 10 A-B
- English 11 A-B
- English 12 A-B (Including Senior Project)

MATHEMATICS

- *Must include Algebra I or the equivalent 30 Credits

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

- Two Years 20 Credits

SCIENCE

- Physical Science (10 Credits)
- Biological Science (10 Credits) 20 Credits

SOCIAL STUDIES

- 9th :: Physical Geography (5 Credits) 35 Credits
- 10th :: World History/Culture/Geography A-B (10 Credits)
- 11th :: US History A-B (10 Credits)
- 12th :: US Government (5 Credits)
- 12th :: Economics (5 Credits)

FINE ARTS or FOREIGN LANGUAGE

- *A course in American Sign Language is deemed a course in Foreign Language. 10 Credits

- Completion of Health and Computer Education
- A passing score on the District Writing Assessment
- Successfully complete Senior Project
- Earn a passing score on the High School Exit Exam

II. CREDIT LIMITATIONS

- Office Aide & School Aide
Up to only 20 Credits
- Physical Education
Up to only 40 Credits applied toward Graduation
- Combined areas of Work Experience Education and Regional Occupation Education (ROP) or Adult Education (Vocational or Electives) courses.
Up to only 60 Credits applied toward Graduation

III. Credits are granted on the basis of the number of class periods per semester. A student receiving a passing grade receives 5 credits per class per semester..
