

SAMPLES OF BPUSD FOUR-YEAR PLANS

The first four-year plan of classes leads to a BPUSD high school diploma. The second four-year plan leads to a high school diploma, as well as four-year college eligibility. Taking classes in summer school is a good way for students to get ahead in Art, Foreign Language and Math and/or make space in their schedules during the following year to take other elective classes.
