- *Must have a minimum unweighted GPA of 3.0
- *Must enroll at an accredited higher education college in 2020-2021
- *Be of Hispanic heritage (includes Spain, Brazil & Philippines)
- *Be a U.S. citizen, permanent resident or qualify under the DACA
