S.V.H.S. Students: This is an urgent message. It has come to the attention of B.P.U.S.D. ETS that we may be under attack by hackers who are attempting to gain access to our sensitive information through phishing emails. Phishing is a type of cyberattack where an attacker sends a fraudulent email in an attempt to trick the recipient into revealing sensitive information or clicking on a malicious link. These emails can look very convincing and can even appear to be from a trusted source, so it's important that we are all vigilant and on the lookout for any suspicious emails. To help protect our district from these types of attacks, I would like to ask all students to be extra careful when opening emails from unknown senders, clicking on links or downloading attachments. If you receive an email that seems suspicious or asks for sensitive information, please do not hesitate to report it to our ETS/IT department immediately. Note: the only way that a hacker can get into your account is by YOU clicking on the link and inputting your bpsud username and password. If you do not enter your bpsud username and password there is no need to worry.

Attention ALL Sierra Vista students who plan to play a sport for the 2023-2024 school year: Clearance time is upon us. The physical that you have on record in the Athletics Office will not be valid for summer of next school year. You must stop by the Athletics Office, Room 316, to pick up a medical clearance form. Your first step is to get a physical. That can be done with your own physician or Dr. Yepez who will be here on campus in the Stadium Team Room on Tuesday, May 16th, and Tuesday, May 23rd. Bring \$25 in cash and you can get a physical which will cover you for the whole 2023-2024 school year. Any questions, see Mrs. Garcia in the Athletics Office. Time is ticking, don't wait to take care of your clearance.

### Seniors

Seniors: If you have charges, you must get those cleared in order to participate in the graduation practices and the graduation ceremony. All seniors that have their charges cleared by May 19th will receive a ticket to get lunch from the In-N-Out Truck on May 31st, the seniors last day on campus. There is a charge list in ASB and office staff can check for you too. Check it if you are not sure if you have any charges. We've also been sending messages home weekly.
